OWNER/APPLICANT agrees to make this occupancy in accordance with the terms and conditions of the Frontier County Commissioners. This permit shall be NULL and VOID if the work specified in the permit is not completed within six (6) months from the date of issuance of this permit. Any extension in time will be requested in writing from the owner/applicant and approval of extension will be granted in writing from the Frontier County Commissioners. The owner/applicant may cancel the permit with written notification at any time prior to the beginning of work on the described occupancy.

OWNER/APPLICANT TO BE RESPONSIBLE for any damage and/or destruction to any other utility in place at the location of requested occupancy. It is further the responsibility of the person/s making the application to locate and identify any other utility in existence, at described location, and to contact the digging hot-line prior to the start of work.

OWNER/APPLICANT TO BE RESPONSIBLE for the occupancy item and any damage to county road right-of-way or county road as a result of such installation. In addition, owner shall be responsible for removal of said item when county road construction requires, at no expense to Frontier County.

DEPTH OF BURY: Items to be installed underground shall be installed at a minimum depth of forty-two (42) inches below the bottom elevation of the road ditch and a corresponding depth below the roadway.

BORING: Underground installations that cross under a hard surfaced road shall be installed by boring under said road so as not to disturb the road surface. Depth shall be as referenced above. Non-hard surfaced roads may also be crossed by under boring.

BACKFILL: All trench and/or boring sites shall be water packed and backfilled by mechanical tamping the full width and length of the disturbed right-of-way to preclude the possibility of settlement in the roadway and washing in the ditches. Supervision of backfilling by a designated county employee, shall be at the discretion of the authorizing County Commissioner.

LOCATOR LINE: To aid in the future location of any underground utility a "locator line" shall be buried at the location of the utility at the time of installation, at the expense of the landowner.

NOTE: Two sets of plans for the proposed work requested herein shall be submitted with this application.
