The Board of Frontier County Commissioners met pursuant to adjournment in regular session on February 5, 2020, with the following present: Steven J. Hall, Chairman, Kevin Owens, Vice-Chairman, J.R. Houser, board member and Darla M. Walther, County Clerk. Chairman Hall called the meeting to order at 9:05 A.M. and stated that the open meetings act is posted on the wall, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. Owens moved to approve the agenda, Houser seconded. Roll call vote- Owens, Aye; Houser, Aye; Hall, Aye. Owens moved to approve the minutes from the January 29, 2020 meeting; Houser seconded. Roll call vote- Owens, Aye; Houser, Aye; Hall, Aye. Houser reported on the NACO Legislative Meeting that he attended. Hall moved to approve the claims including Eustis Welding and Repair claim over ninety days old, Owens seconded. Roll call vote- Owens, Aye; Houser, Aye; Hall, Aye.

At 9:15 A.M. Chairman Hall opened the Board of Equalization meeting. Hall opened the public hearing to review form 451 permissive exemption applications. Present was Regina Andrijeski, County Assessor. At 9:22 A.M. Chairman Hall closed the public hearing. Owens moved to approve nineteen permissive exemption form 451 applications, Houser seconded. Roll call vote- Owens, Aye; Hall, Aye; Houser, Aye. Chairman Hall closed the Board of Equalization meeting at 9:23 a.m. and the County Board returned to regular session.

At 11:00 A.M. Jon Schroeder, County Attorney, was present to answer legal questions.

Present for discussion on the Riddle Bridge was Phillip Leising who will do a cost estimate for the project. Also present at various times during the meeting was Dan Rupp, County Sheriff.

Houser moved to declare the 1977 Crippen seed cleaner as surplus property valued at under \$2,500.00; Hall seconded. Roll call vote- Owens, Aye; Hall, Aye; Houser, Aye. Hall moved to sign Resolution #20-6 to transfer \$4,082.62 from the Emergency 911 Fund to the Wireless 911 Fund to correct errors found upon audit; Owens seconded. Roll call vote- Owens, Aye; Houser, Aye; Hall, Aye. Discussion was held regarding purchase of the Moorefield State Yard. Hall moved to purchase the Moorefield State Yard for \$7,500.00; Owens seconded. Roll call vote- Owens, Aye; Houser, Aye; Hall, Aye. Houser submitted a written report regarding surplus property that was not disposed of. Houser moved to undeclare a D6 Caterpillar Dozer and John Deere 770CH Grader and return them to inventory; Owens seconded. Roll call vote- Houser, Aye; Hall, Aye; Owens, Aye. A sprinkler system and well was discussed for the courthouse.

The Clerk of the District Court Report was reviewed and placed on file. A letter regarding jail standards visit to the jail was received. A letter from Miller and Associates regarding section corners was received.
