The Board of Frontier County Commissioners met pursuant to adjournment in regular session on June 25, 2020, with the following present: Steven J. Hall, Chairman, Kevin Owens, Vice-Chairman, J.R. Houser, Board Member and Darla M. Walther, County Clerk. Chairman Hall called the meeting to order at 9:02 A.M. and stated that the open meetings act is posted on the wall, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. Owens moved to approve the Agenda, Houser seconded. Roll call vote- Owens, Aye; Houser, Aye; Hall, Aye. Owens moved to approve the minutes from the June 24, 2020 meeting; Hall seconded. Roll call vote- Owens, Aye; Houser, Aye; Hall, Aye. Houser moved to approve the claims, Owens seconded. Roll call vote- Owens, Aye; Hall, Aye; Houser, Aye.

Houser moved to sign Resolution #20-21 to reassign \$25,584.49 of over expended funds within the Road Budget; Hall seconded. Roll call vote- Hall, Aye; Owens, Aye; Houser, Aye. Hall moved to sign Resolution #20-22 to reassign \$941.00 of over expended funds within the General Budget; Houser seconded. Roll call vote- Houser- Aye; Owens, Aye; Hall, Aye. Owens moved to sign Resolution #20-23 to transfer \$150,000.00 from the Inheritance Tax Fund to the Courthouse Building fund; Houser seconded. Roll call vote- Owens, Aye; Houser, Aye; Hall, Aye. Present by telephone was Kurt Vosburg with the Nebraska Department of Roads to discuss moving an approach to Highway 83 because of poor sight distance. Mr. Vosburg explained that the studies do not support the state expending the funds to move the approach. Owens asked if the county expended the funds to move the road if the state would be interested in working on the approach within their right of way. Mr. Vosburg agreed that a project of this nature would best be served by the county and state working together, however it was too late to add the approach to the current project but could be looked at in the future as a joint project. Owens moved to purchase a pickup from Deveny Motors for \$6,700.00 for the weed control department; Hall seconded. Roll call vote- Hall, Aye; Houser, Aye; Owens, Aye. Hall moved to declare the Crippen Seed Cleaner along with its trailer and 1999 International Truck worth more than \$2,500 as surplus property; Houser seconded.
