The Board of Frontier County Commissioners met pursuant to adjournment in regular session on August 5, 2020, with the following present: Steven J. Hall, Chairman, Kevin Owens, Vice-Chairman, J.R. Houser, Board Member and Darla M. Walther, County Clerk. Chairman Hall called the meeting to order at 9:08 A.M. and stated that the open meetings act is posted on the wall, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. Houser moved to approve the Agenda, Owens seconded. Roll call vote- Owens, Aye; Houser, Aye; Hall, Aye. Owens moved to approve the minutes from the July 29, 2020 meeting with the addition that Corey Steel was present by telephone; Houser seconded. Roll call vote- Owens, Aye; Houser, Aye; Hall, Aye. Owens moved to approve the claims, Houser seconded. Roll call vote- Owens, Aye; Hall, Aye; Houser, Aye with Houser and Hall abstaining each on their own claim.

At 9:37 A.M. Chairman Hall opened the Board of Equalization meeting. Hall moved to approve a tax list correction for Arlo Banzhaf; Owens seconded. Roll call vote- Owens, Aye; Hall, Aye; Houser, aye. At 9:40 the board returned to regular session.

At 11:00 A.M. Steve Granger met with the board to review plans for improvements to the courthouse.

Houser moved to approve Resolution 20-25 whereby the Frontier County Treasurer is ordered to release Custody Receipt #620752CG8 to the Community First Bank and accept in its place Custody Receipt #34G82AUC3 from the Community First Bank, Owens Seconded. Roll call vote- Owens, Aye; Hall, Aye; Houser, Aye. Owens moved to sign a letter appointing Roger Powell as representative for disaster relief 4521; Hall seconded. Roll call vote- Owens, Aye; Hall, Aye; Houser, Aye. Owens moved to sign Resolution #20-24 to set the preliminary levies for Frontier County Subdivisions; Hall seconded. Roll call vote- Houser, Aye; Hall, Aye; Owens, Aye. The preliminary budget numbers were discussed.
