The Board of Frontier County Commissioners met pursuant to adjournment in regular session on December 30, 2020, with the following present: Steven J. Hall, Chairman, Kevin Owens, Vice-Chairman, J.R. Houser, Board Member and Darla M. Walther, County Clerk. Chairman Hall called the meeting to order at 9:00 A.M. and stated that the open meetings act is posted on the wall, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. Owens moved to approve the Agenda, Houser seconded. Roll call vote- Owens, Aye; Houser, Aye; Hall, Aye. Owens moved to approve the minutes from the December 8, 2020 meeting; Hall seconded. At 10:00 Kathy Burr, Extension Educator, met with the board to discuss the Extension Office. Houser moved to declare surplus a list of obsolete items; Owens seconded. At 10:30 A.M. Roger Powell, Frontier County Emergency Manager, met with the board to discuss emergency management.

Also present at various times during the meeting was Dan Rupp, County Sheriff.
